

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 1014

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Madge Cleveland
to the Heritage Conservation Trust Fund Board.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 11-7-104(a), provides for the creation
of the Heritage Conservation Trust Fund Board; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 11-7-104(b), provides that the
Governor shall appoint eleven members to the board; and

WHEREAS, Governor Bill Lee has appointed Madge Cleveland as a member of the
Heritage Conservation Trust Fund Board representing East Tennessee, to a term that will expire
on October 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, a 1978 graduate of Rhodes College, Mrs. Cleveland currently serves as
vice president of the Foothill Land Conservancy Board; and

WHEREAS, she has worked in campaigns and governmental offices for Senator Lamar
Alexander and former Mayor Victor Ashe. She has also worked in public relations and served
as a technical writer for Ingram Group and Child and Family Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Cleveland is a person of integrity and an active citizen whose
benevolence, acumen, and strong commitment to public service have helped to enhance the
well-being of this State and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 11-7-104(b)(2), provides that each
member appointed by the Governor to the Heritage Conservation Trust Fund Board shall be
confirmed by joint resolution of the General Assembly; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED ELEVENTH GENERAL
ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

CONCURRING, that this body does hereby confirm the appointment of Madge Cleveland to the Heritage Conservation Trust Fund Board for a term that will expire on October 31, 2023.
