A BILL

To appropriate funds to U.S. Customs and Border Protection for the deployment of nonintrusive inspection technology at the southern land border of the United States.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Deploy Fentanyl Scan-
- 5 ners Act of 2024".

1	SEC. 2. APPROPRIATION OF AMOUNTS TO INSTALL NON-
2	INTRUSIVE INSPECTION TECHNOLOGY AT
3	THE SOUTHERN BORDER.
4	There are appropriated, out of any money in the
5	Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to U.S. Customs
6	and Border Protection $\$201,000,000$ for fiscal year 2024
7	for the deployment of nonintrusive inspection technology
8	at the southern land border of the United States.
