A BILL

 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. RESEARCH ON THE MENTAL HEALTH IMPACT
 - 4 **OF COVID-19.**
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Health and
- 6 Human Services (in this section referred to as the "Sec-
- 7 retary"), acting through the Director of the National In-

1	stitute of Mental Health, shall conduct or support re-
2	search on the mental health consequences of SARS–CoV–
3	2 or COVID-19.
4	(b) Use of Funds.—Research under subsection (a)
5	may include—
6	(1) research on the mental health impact of
7	SARS-CoV-2 or COVID-19 on health care pro-
8	viders, including—
9	(A) traumatic stress;
10	(B) psychological distress; and
11	(C) psychiatric disorders; and
12	(2) research on the impact of SARS-CoV-2 or
13	COVID-19 stressors on mental health over time;
14	(3) research to strengthen the mental health re-
15	sponse to SARS-CoV-2 or COVID-19, including
16	adapting to and maintaining or providing additional
17	services for new or increasing mental health needs;
18	(4) research on the reach, efficiency, effective-
19	ness, and quality of digital mental health interven-
20	tions;
21	(5) research on the effectiveness of strategies
22	for implementation and delivery of evidence-based
23	mental health interventions and services for under-
24	served populations; and
25	(6) research on suicide prevention.

- 1 (c) RESEARCH COORDINATION.—The Secretary shall
- 2 coordinate activities under this section with similar activi-
- 3 ties conducted by national research institutes and centers
- 4 of the National Institutes of Health to the extent that
- 5 such institutes and centers have responsibilities that are
- 6 related to the mental health consequences of SARS-CoV-
- 7 2 or COVID-19.
- 8 (d) Authorization of Appropriations.—To carry
- 9 out this section, there is authorized to be appropriated
- 10 \$100,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2021 through 2025,
- 11 to remain available until expended.
