Medical Assistance Program – Emergency Service Transporters –
Reimbursement for Transportation and Medical Services

FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Department of Health to reimburse at a certain rate certain emergency service transporters for mileage accrued in response to certain calls related to Maryland Medical Assistance Program recipients; requiring the Department to increase the amount of certain reimbursement by a certain amount each fiscal year, beginning in a certain fiscal year, until the rate is at least a certain amount; and generally relating to reimbursement for services provided by emergency service transporters.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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- 20 (a) In this section, "emergency service transporter" means a public entity or 21 volunteer fire, rescue, or emergency medical service that provides emergency medical 22 services.
 - (b) [If] SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, IF an emergency

- 1 service transporter charges for its services and requests reimbursement from the Program,
- 2 the Department shall reimburse the emergency service transporter, in an amount as
- 3 specified by regulations adopted by the Department, for the cost of:
- 4 (1) Transportation the emergency service transporter provides to a 5 Program recipient to a facility in response to a 911 call; and
- 6 (2) Medical services the emergency service transporter provides to the 7 Program recipient while transporting the Program recipient to a facility in response to a
