A BILL

- To amend title 38, United States Code, to codify the authority of the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to assign a disability rating of total to a veteran by reason of unemployability, and for other purposes.

 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Protecting Benefits
- 5 for Disabled Veterans Act of 2019".

1 SEC. 2. CODIFICATION OF INDIVIDUAL UNEMPLOYABILITY.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 11 of title 38, United
3 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 1163
4 the following:

5 "\$1164. Determination of total disability by reason of unemployability

7 "(a) AUTHORITY.—Subject to subsections (b) and 8 (c), for the purposes of this chapter, in the case of a vet-9 eran who has a service-connected disability, or service-con-10 nected disabilities, not rated as total, the Secretary may 11 assign a disability rating of total to the veteran if the Sec-12 retary determines the veteran—

13	"(1) is unable to secure or maintain substan-
14	tially gainful employment as a result of, in part or
15	in whole, a service-connected disability; and
16	"(2) has—
17	"(A) a service-connected disability rated at
18	least 60 percent; or
19	"(B) two or more service-connected disabil-
20	ities—
21	"(i) at least one of which is rated at
22	least 40 percent; and
23	"(ii) that, combined, are rated at least
24	70 percent.
25	"(b) Determination of Certain Disabilities.—
26	For the above purpose of service-connected disabilities de-
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scribed in subsection (a)(2), the Secretary shall consider
as one disability the following:
"(1) Disabilities of one or both upper extrem-
ities, or of one or both lower extremities, including
the bilateral factor, if applicable.
"(2) Disabilities resulting from common eti-
ology or a single accident.
"(3) Disabilities affecting a single body system
(including orthopedic, digestive, respiratory, cardio-
vascular-renal, and neuropsychiatric).
"(4) Disabilities incurred or aggravated as a
prisoner of war.
"(c) Additional Authority of the Secretary
TO ASSIGN A DISABILITY RATING OF TOTAL.—The Sec-
retary may assign a disability rating of total to a veteran
who has a service-connected disability or disabilities de-
scribed in subsection (a)(2)—
((1)) if the veteran maintains marginal employ-
ment; or
"(2) if—
"(A) the veteran maintains substantially
gainful employment; and
"(B) the Secretary, considering the totality
of circumstances (including total household
medical expenses and the cost of living in the

area in which the veteran resides), determines
 that such assignation is appropriate.
 "(d) PROHIBITION ON THE CONSIDERATION OF CER TAIN FACTORS.—In making any determination under sub section (a) or (c), the Secretary may not consider the fol lowing:

7 "(1) The age of a veteran.

8 "(2) The eligibility of a veteran for any retire9 ment benefit, including any benefit under title II of
10 the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 401 et seq.).

11 "(e) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

"(1) The term 'marginal employment' means
employment for which the earned annual income is
less than 100 percent of the official poverty threshold for an individual established by the United
States Census Bureau.

17 "(2) The term 'substantially gainful employ18 ment' means employment for which the earned an19 nual income equals or exceeds 100 percent of the of20 ficial poverty threshold for an individual established
21 by the United States Census Bureau.".

(b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
at the beginning of chapter 11 of title 38, United States
Code, is amended by adding after the item relating to section 1163 the following:

"1164. Determination of total disability by reason of unemployability.".

(c) REGULATIONS.—Not later than 180 days after
 the effective date of this Act, the Secretary of Veterans
 Affairs shall prescribe such regulations as may be nec essary to carry out this section.
