# AN ACT

- To amend title 38, United States Code, to authorize the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to waive the requirement of certain veterans to make copayments for hospital care and medical services in the case of an error by the Department of Veterans Affairs, and for other purposes.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

## 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "VA Billing Account-3 ability Act".

4 SEC. 2. AUTHORITY OF SECRETARY OF VETERANS AFFAIRS
5 TO WAIVE REQUIREMENT OF CERTAIN VET6 ERANS TO MAKE COPAYMENTS FOR CARE
7 AND SERVICES IN THE CASE OF DEPART8 MENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS ERROR.

9 (a) HOSPITAL CARE, NURSING HOME CARE, AND
10 MEDICAL SERVICES.—Section 1710(f)(3) of title 38,
11 United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the
12 following new subparagraph:

13 "(G) The Secretary may waive the requirement of a
14 veteran to make a payment under this subsection or sub15 section (g) if—

"(i) an error committed by the Department or
an employee of the Department was the cause of delaying notification sent to the veteran of the requirement to make the payment; and

"(ii) the veteran received such notification later
than 180 days after the date on which the veteran
received the care or services for which the payment
was required.".

(b) MEDICATIONS.—Section 1722A of such title is
amended—

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1	(1) by redesignating subsection (c) as sub-
2	section (d); and
3	(2) by inserting after subsection (b) the fol-
4	lowing new subsection (c):
5	"(c) The Secretary may waive the requirement of a
6	veteran to make a payment under this section if—
7	"(1) an error committed by the Department or
8	an employee of the Department was the cause of de-
9	laying notification sent to the veteran of the require-
10	ment to make the payment; and
11	((2) the veteran received such notification later
12	than 180 days after the date on which the veteran
13	received the medication for which the payment was
14	required.".
15	(c) BILLING PROCEDURES.—
16	(1) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter I of chapter 17
17	of such title is amended by adding at the end the
18	following new section:
19	"§ 1709C. Procedures for copayments
20	"(a) CARE AT DEPARTMENT FACILITY.—(1) In re-
21	quiring a veteran to make a payment for care or services
22	provided at a medical facility of the Department pursuant
23	to this chapter, including sections $1710$ and $1722A$ , the
24	Secretary shall provide to such veteran a notification of
25	such required payment by not later than 180 days after

the date on which the veteran receives the care or services
 for which payment is required.

3 "(2) If the Secretary does not provide to a veteran
4 a notification of the required payment by the date required
5 under paragraph (1), the Secretary may not collect such
6 payment, including through a third-party entity, unless
7 the Secretary provides the veteran the following:

8 "(A) Information regarding how to apply for a
9 waiver described in section 1710(f)(3)(G) or section
10 1722A(c) of this title, as appropriate.

11 "(B) Information regarding how to establish a12 payment plan with the Secretary.

13 "(C) Opportunity to make such a waiver or es-14 tablish such a payment plan.

15 "(b) CARE AT NON-DEPARTMENT FACILITY.—(1) In requiring a veteran to make a payment for care or services 16 provided at a non-Department facility pursuant to this 17 chapter or other provision of law, the Secretary shall pro-18 vide to such veteran a notification of such required pay-19 ment by not later than 18 months after the date on which 20 the veteran receives the care or services for which payment 21 22 is required.

"(2) If the Secretary does not provide to a veteran
a notification of the required payment by the date required
under paragraph (1), the Secretary may not collect such

1	payment, including through a third-party entity, unless
2	the Secretary provides the veteran the following:
3	"(A) Information regarding how to apply for a
4	waiver described in paragraph (3).
5	"(B) Information regarding how to establish a
6	payment plan with the Secretary.
7	"(C) Opportunity to make such a waiver or es-
8	tablish such a payment plan.
9	"(3) The Secretary may waive the requirement of a
10	veteran to make a payment for care or services provided
11	at a non-Department facility pursuant to this chapter or
12	other provision of law if—
13	"(A) an error committed by the Department, an
14	employee of the Department, or a non-Department
15	facility was the cause of delaying the notification
16	sent to the veteran of the requirement to make the
17	payment; and
18	"(B) the veteran received such notification after
19	the period described in paragraph (1).".
20	(2) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sec-
21	tions at the beginning of such chapter is amended
22	by inserting after the item relating to section 1709B
23	the following new item:

"1709C. Procedures for copayments.".

(d) IMPROVEMENT OF PROCEDURES.—Not later than
 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the
 Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall—

4 (1) review the copayment billing internal con5 trols and notification procedures of the Department
6 of Veterans Affairs; and

7 (2) improve such controls and procedures, in8 cluding pursuant to the amendments made by this
9 Act.
