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## Insurance - Universal and Variable Life Insurance - Notice

FOR the purpose of requiring certain insurers to send a notice to policyholders of universal or variable life insurance if the policy contains a provision that allows the policyholder to reduce the face amount of the policy; requiring that the notice state certain information; authorizing the insurer to include certain information in a certain billing statement; requiring that the notice be sent to a certain address at certain times; and generally relating to policies of universal and variable life insurance.

- 15 (2) AT LEAST 30 DAYS BEFORE TERMINATION OF COVERAGE.
