A BILL

To amend the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act to prohibit the local regulation of pesticide use, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITING LOCAL REGULATION OF PES-
- 4 TICIDE USE.
- 5 Section 24 of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and
- 6 Rodenticide Act (7 U.S.C. 136v) is amended—
- 7 (1) in the section heading by inserting "AND
- 8 **LOCALITIES**" after "**STATES**"; and

- 1 (2) by adding at the end the following:
- 2 "(d) Local Regulation Prohibited.—A political
- 3 subdivision of a State shall not impose, or continue in ef-
- 4 fect, any requirement relating to the sale, distribution, la-
- 5 beling, application, or use of any pesticide or device sub-
- 6 ject to regulation by a State pursuant to this section or
- 7 by the Administrator under this Act.".
