A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Health Benefit Exchange – Application for State Innovation Waiver**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring, on or before a certain date, the Board of Trustees of the
4 Maryland Health Benefit Exchange to apply for a certain waiver to allow certain
5 individuals to enroll in qualified health plans offered through the Maryland Health
6 Benefit Exchange; and generally relating to the Maryland Health Benefit Exchange
7 and enrollment in qualified health plans.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Insurance**

16 **31–120.**

17 **ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1, 2017, THE BOARD SHALL APPLY TO THE U.S.**
18 **SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR A STATE INNOVATION WAIVER**
19 **UNDER § 1332 OF THE AFFORDABLE CARE ACT TO ALLOW AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS**
