A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 66 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 zoning procedures, so as to define the term "family" in relation to local governments
- 3 exercising zoning powers or administering and enforcing building, housing, or property
- 4 maintenance codes; to define other terms; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
- 5 laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7	SECTION 1.
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- 8 Chapter 66 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to zoning
- 9 procedures, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 10 "<u>36-66-7.</u>
- 11 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- (1) 'Disabled household' means a household whose head, including any co-head, spouse,
- or sole member, is a disabled person, including two or more disabled persons living
- together or one or more disabled persons living with one or more live-in aides.
- 15 (2) 'Disabled person' means a person who has a physical, mental, developmental, or
- 16 <u>emotional impairment that:</u>
- 17 (A) Is expected to be of long-continued and indefinite duration;
- (B) Substantially impedes his or her ability to live independently; and
- 19 (C) Is of such a nature that such ability could be improved by more suitable housing
- 20 <u>conditions.</u>
- 21 (3) 'Elderly household' means a household whose head, including any co-head, spouse,
- or sole member, is a person who is at least 62 years of age, including two or more persons
- 23 who are at least 62 years of age living together or one or more persons who are least 62
- 24 <u>years of age living with one or more live-in aides.</u>
- 25 (4) 'Elderly person' means a person who is at least 62 years of age.
- 26 (5) 'Family' means:

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27	(A) A single person, who may be an elderly person, disabled person, near-elderly
28	person, or any other single person; or
29	(B) A group of persons residing together and such group includes, but is not limited
30	<u>to:</u>
31	(i) A household with or without children, including a child who is temporarily away
32	from the household because of placement in foster care;
33	(ii) An elderly household;
34	(iii) A near-elderly household;
35	(iv) A disabled household; and
36	(v) The remaining members of a household.
37	(6) 'Near-elderly household' means a household whose head, including co-head, spouse,
38	or sole member, is a person who is at least 50 years of age but below the age of 62, two
39	or more persons who are at least 50 years of age but below the age of 62 living together,
40	or one or more persons who are at least 50 years of age but below the age of 62 living
41	with one or more live-in aides.
42	(7) 'Near-elderly person' means a person who is at least 50 years of age but below the age
43	<u>of 62.</u>
44	(b) No county, municipality, consolidated government, or any authority, board, or
45	commission of a county, municipality, or consolidated government exercising zoning
46	powers whether created by or pursuant to a general state law, a local act of the General
47	Assembly, or a local constitutional amendment shall be authorized to use any other
48	definition of the term 'family' than that provided for in paragraph (5) of subsection (a) of
49	this Code section for any zoning decision, the exercise of zoning powers, or the
50	administration and enforcement of any building, development, housing, or property
51	maintenance codes."

52 **SECTION 2.**

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
