3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Winnebago Land5 Transfer Act of 2023".

1 SEC. 2. LAND TO BE TAKEN INTO TRUST.

2	(a) IN GENERAL.—Subject to all valid existing rights,
3	all right, title, and interest (including improvements and
4	appurtenances) of the United States in and to the Federal
5	lands described in subsection (b), those Federal lands—
6	(1) are declared to be part of the Winnebago
7	Reservation created by the Treaty between the
8	United States and the Winnebago Tribe in 1865;
9	and
10	(2) shall be held in trust by the United States
11	for the benefit of the Winnebago Tribe of Nebraska
12	subject to the same terms and conditions as those
13	lands described in the Treaty with the Winnebago
14	Tribe, 1865 (14 Stat. 671).
15	(b) Federal Lands Described.—The Federal
16	lands described in this subsection are the following:
17	(1) That portion of Tract No. 119, the descrip-
18	tion of which is filed in the United States District
19	Court for the Northern District of Iowa (Western
20	Division), Civil Case No. 70–C–3015–W, executed
21	May 11, 1973, said tract being situated in Section
22	8 and the accretion land thereto, the Southwest
23	Quarter of Section 9, the West Half of Section 16,
24	the East Half of Section 17, Township 86 North,
25	Range 47 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian,
