5 (a) CLARIFICATION.—Section 4(c)(1) of the Billfish
6 Conservation Act of 2012 (16 U.S.C. 1827a(c)(1)) is
7 amended by inserting "and retained" after "landed".

8 (b) DEADLINE FOR REGULATIONS.—The Secretary
9 of Commerce shall issue a final rule implementing the Bill10 fish Conservation Act of 2012 (16 U.S.C. 1827a), as
