- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "EARLY Act Reauthor-
- 5 ization of 2019".
- 6 SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF THE YOUNG WOMEN'S
- 7 BREAST HEALTH EDUCATION AND AWARE-
- 8 NESS REQUIRES LEARNING YOUNG ACT OF
- 9 2009.
- 10 Section 399NN(h) of the Public Health Service Act
- 11 (42 U.S.C. 280m(h)) is amended by striking "\$4,900,000
- 12 for each of fiscal years 2015 through 2019" and inserting
- 13 "\$9,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2020 through 2024".
