- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

17 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section and § 13–805 of this 18 subtitle, the fee for each certificate of title issued under this title is \$100.

19 (b) (1) The fee for each certificate of title issued for a rental vehicle is \$50.

20 (2) The fee for each certificate of title issued for an off-highway 21 recreational vehicle is \$35.

(3) The fee for each certificate of title issued for a motor scooter or a mopedis \$20.

1 (4) THE FEE FOR EACH CERTIFICATE OF TITLE ISSUED FOR A 2 TRAILER WITH A GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT OF **3,000** POUNDS OR LESS IS **\$50** IF:

3 (I) THE TRAILER IS TRANSFERRED TO A SPOUSE, CHILD,
4 GRANDCHILD, PARENT, SIBLING, GRANDPARENT, FATHER-IN-LAW,
5 MOTHER-IN-LAW, SON-IN-LAW, DAUGHTER-IN-LAW, NIECE, OR NEPHEW OF THE
6 TRANSFEROR; AND

7 (II) NO MONEY OR OTHER VALUABLE CONSIDERATION IS 8 INVOLVED IN THE TRANSFER.

9 [(4)] (5) On the death of a joint owner of a vehicle, the Administration 10 may not charge a fee for a new certificate of title issued for the vehicle to another joint 11 owner who is the surviving spouse.

12 (c) The Administration may not charge a fee for a certificate of title issued for a 13 vehicle that is transferred to a trust or from a trust to one or more beneficiaries in 14 accordance with § 14.5–1001 of the Estates and Trusts Article.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 2020.
