"(3) the State in which the member maintains
a place of abode from which the member commutes

7 SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

8 The amendments made by this Act shall apply to con-9 duct engaged in after the 6-month period that begins with10 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
