3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Equal Protection for

5 American Workers Act".

6 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON CERTAIN WORK AUTHORIZA-7 TIONS.

8 Effective beginning on the date of the enactment of9 this Act, the Secretary of Homeland Security is prohibited

from granting a work authorization to an alien who has
been finally determined, in a valid immigration proceeding
during which due process was afforded, to have been at
any time unlawfully present in the United States.
