A BILL ENTITLED

Video Lottery Terminal Proceeds – Racetrack Facility Renewal Account –
Racecourse at Timonium

- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring that, in certain fiscal years, a certain amount of video lottery 5 terminal proceeds distributed to the Racetrack Facility Renewal Account for certain 6 racing licensees be allocated in a certain manner to the racecourse at Timonium for 7 certain expenses; requiring a certain racetrack, under certain circumstances, to 8 provide and expend a matching fund; repealing an obsolete provision; repealing a 9 provision of law that authorizes the holder of a racing license to race at the racecourse at Timonium to use a certain amount of money to support a certain 10 11 number of racing days; and generally relating to the distribution of video lottery 12 terminal proceeds to the Racetrack Facility Renewal Account.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,



- 22 (a) There is a Racetrack Facility Renewal Account under the authority of the 23 State Racing Commission.
- 24 (b) (1) The Account shall receive money as required under § 9–1A–27 of this subtitle for the first 16 years of operations at each video lottery facility.

1 (f) (1)Of For each of fiscal years 2021 through 2025, of the 2 amount provided from the Racetrack Facility Renewal Account under subsection (d)(1) of 3 this section, the racecourse at Timonium shall be provided [the following amounts], for racetrack facility capital construction and improvements [: 4 5 (i) for fiscal year 2012, \$1,125,000; 6 for fiscal year 2013, \$1,250,000; (ii) 7 (iii) for fiscal year 2014, \$1,125,000; 8 for fiscal year 2015, \$1,000,000; and (iv) 9 for fiscal year 2016, \$1,000,000], AN AMOUNT THAT EQUALS (v) 10 THE LESSER OF: 11 **(1)** THE RACECOURSE'S PRO RATA SHARE OF THE AMOUNT PROVIDED 12 UNDER SUBSECTION (D)(1) OF THIS SECTION BASED ON THE NUMBER OF LIVE 13 RACING DAYS AT THE RACECOURSE; OR 14 **(2) \$350,000**. 15 A matching fund is not required for the amount provided for the (2)16 racecourse at Timonium under paragraph (1) of this subsection. 17 From the amounts provided in paragraph (1) of this subsection, 18 the holder of a racing license to race at the racecourse at Timonium may use up to \$350,000 per year to support a minimum of 7 live racing days. 19 20 Use of funds authorized under subparagraph (i) of this 21paragraph must be approved by the Secretary of Labor under terms and a process 22 consistent with the provisions of subsection (j) of this section. 23 Of the amount provided from the Racetrack Facility Renewal Account under 24subsection (d)(1) of this section, the State Racing Commission may provide direct grant 25funding for the establishment of a horse racing museum as part of the Pimlico Race Course. 26 After a grant has been provided under this section, the State Racing (h) 27 Commission shall: 28in consultation with the Department of General Services, monitor the (1)

implementation of the approved capital construction plan; and

- 1 (2) make provisions for recapture of grant moneys if the capital 2 construction plan is not implemented within the time frame approved by the State Racing 3 Commission.
- 4 (i) Any unencumbered funds remaining in the Racetrack Facility Renewal 5 Account after a video lottery facility has been in operation for 16 years shall be paid to the 6 Education Trust Fund established under § 9–1A–30 of this subtitle.
- 7 (j) The State Racing Commission shall adopt regulations to implement the 8 provisions of this subsection, including regulations to address minimum criteria for the 9 types of improvements to be made by the holder of a license.
- 10 (k) The provisions of this section may not be construed to apply to the racecourse 11 in Allegany County.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
