- 3 WHEREAS, Fred Kitchens has devoted his life's career to the Wine and Spirits Wholesalers
- 4 of Georgia, previously known as the Georgia Distilled Spirits Institute, for 44 years and has
- 5 served as the association's executive director for the past 30 years; and

- 16 Georgia's Scholarship Foundation, which has delivered nearly \$1.5 million in scholarships
- 17 to students attending Georgia colleges; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Fred Kitchens graduated from the University of Georgia as a "Double Dawg,"
- 19 with an undergraduate degree in journalism and a juris doctor degree thereafter, and he is a
- 20 lifetime supporter of the Bulldogs and proud member of the Gridiron Society, "sic vos non
- vobis"; and
