3 Section 844 of the Homeland Security Act of 2002
4 (6 U.S.C. 414) is amended by adding at the end the fol5 lowing new subsection:

6 "(b) INTELLIGENCE ROTATIONAL ASSIGNMENT PRO-7 GRAM.—

8 "(1) ESTABLISHMENT.—The Secretary shall es-9 tablish an Intelligence Rotational Assignment Pro-10 gram as part of the Rotation Program under sub-11 section (a).

12 "(2) ADMINISTRATION.—The Chief Human
13 Capital Officer, in conjunction with the Chief Intel14 ligence Officer, shall administer the Intelligence Ro15 tational Assignment Program established pursuant
16 to paragraph (1).

17 "(3) ELIGIBLITY.—The Intelligence Rotational
18 Assignment Program established pursuant to para19 graph (1) shall be open to employees serving in ex20 isting analyst positions within the Department's In21 telligence Enterprise and other Department employ22 ees as determined appropriate by the Chief Human
23 Capital Officer and the Chief Intelligence Officer.

24 "(4) COORDINATION.—The responsibilities
25 specified in paragraph (3)(B) of subsection (a) that

section shall, as applicable, also apply to the Intel ligence Rotational Assignment Program under this
 subsection.".
