SENATE BILL 1901

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Employee Insurance and Benefits Act; requiring Oklahoma Employees Insurance and Benefits Board to collaborate with Oklahoma Health Care Authority for certain purpose by certain date; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7010 of Title 36, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Employees Insurance and Benefits Board shall collaborate with the Oklahoma Health Care Authority by July 1, 2021, to eliminate the use of a third-party pharmacy benefit management company and replace this company with a direct-to-pharmacy payment system, the pricing of which shall be established jointly by the Board and Health Care Authority for the purposes of lowering the prescription drug prices for the benefit of the enrollees of any health insurance plan offered pursuant to the Oklahoma Employee Insurance and Benefits Act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.

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
