A BILL

To rename the Homestead National Monument of America near Beatrice, Nebraska, as the Homestead National Historical Park.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. HOMESTEAD NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK.
- 4 (a) In General.—The first section of the Act of
- 5 March 19, 1936 (49 Stat. 1184, chapter 157; 16 U.S.C.
- 6 450u) is amended by striking "designated" and all that
- 7 follows through the end and inserting "designated as the
- 8 'Homestead National Historical Park'.".

- 1 (b) References.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
- 2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
- 3 States to the unit of the National Park System known
- 4 as "The Homestead National Monument of America"
- 5 shall be considered to be a reference to the "Homestead
- 6 National Historical Park".
- 7 (c) Effect.—Nothing in this Act or an amendment
- 8 made by this Act authorizes a change in the management
- 9 of the Homestead National Historical Park redesignated
- 10 under subsection (a).
