A BILL

To extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE FOR HYDRO-
- 4 ELECTRIC PROJECT.
- 5 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding the time period
- 6 specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16
- 7 U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply to the Federal En-
- 8 ergy Regulatory Commission project numbered 12642, the
- 9 Commission may, at the request of the licensee for the
- 10 project, and after reasonable notice, in accordance with

- 1 the good faith, due diligence, and public interest require-
- 2 ments of that section and the procedures of the Commis-
- 3 sion under that section, extend the time period during
- 4 which the licensee is required to commence the construc-
- 5 tion of the project for up to 3 consecutive 2-year periods
- 6 from the date of the expiration of the extension originally
- 7 issued by the Commission.
- 8 (b) REINSTATEMENT OF EXPIRED LICENSE.—If the
- 9 period required for commencement of construction of the
- 10 project described in subsection (a) has expired prior to the
- 11 date of enactment of this Act—
- 12 (1) the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission
- may reinstate the license effective as of the date of
- the expiration of the license; and
- 15 (2) the first extension authorized under sub-
- section (a) shall take effect on that expiration date.
