17	shall establish or provide for a legal division and the Director may
18	employ two attorneys as needed, which attorneys, in addition to
19	advising the Director, the Commission and employees of the Bureau or
20	legal matters, may appear for and represent the Director, the
21	Commission and employees of the Bureau in administrative hearings
22	and other legal actions and proceedings. No Bureau attorney shall
23	enter an appearance in a criminal action nor engage in private
24	practice of the law while in the employment of the Oklahoma State

1	Bureau of Investigation, except for the purpose of representing the
2	agency in motions to quash subpoenas, other discovery matters,
3	expungement applications, evidentiary hearings, and forfeiture

6	official opinions to and to prosecute and defend actions for the
7	Director, Commission and employees of the Bureau, if requested to do
8	so.
