4 (a) (B) An individual simultaneously may not be a candidate for more than one
 5 <u>ELECTED</u> public office.

6 (b) (C) An individual simultaneously may not be a candidate for more than one 7 office of a political party.

8 (e) (D) Unless otherwise prohibited by rule of the applicable political party, an]
9 AN individual simultaneously may NOT be a candidate for a party office and a AN
10 ELECTED public office.

11(D) (E)AN INDIVIDUAL SIMULTANEOUSLY MAY NOT HOLD A PARTY12OFFICE AND A AN ELECTED PUBLIC OFFICE.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 14 January 1, 2021.
