3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

1	SEC. 2. WAIVER OF LIMITATIONS ON EXPANSION OF FACIL-
2	ITY CAPACITY UNDER RURAL PROVIDER AND
3	HOSPITAL EXCEPTION TO OWNERSHIP OR IN-
4	VESTMENT PROHIBITION DURING
5	CORONAVIRUS 2020 EMERGENCY PERIOD.
6	Section $1877(i)(1)(B)$ of the Social Security Act (42)
7	U.S.C. 1395nn(i)(1)(B)) is amended—
8	(1) by striking "CAPACITY.—Except as provided
9	in paragraph (3), the number" and inserting "CA-
10	PACITY.—
11	"(i) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in
12	paragraph (3) and subject to clause (ii), the
13	number;"; and
14	(2) by adding at the end the following new
15	clause:
16	"(ii) EXCEPTION DURING
17	CORONAVIRUS 2020 EMERGENCY PERIOD.—
18	"(I) IN GENERAL.—The limita-
19	tion under clause (i) shall not apply
20	with respect to any increase in the
21	number of operating rooms, procedure
22	rooms, or beds for which a hospital is
23	licensed during the coronavirus 2020
24	emergency period, or for which the
25	hospital begins construction during
26	the coronavirus 2020 emergency pe-

1	riod regardless of whether the hospital
2	is an applicable hospital (as defined in
3	paragraph $(3)(E)$) or is a high Med-
4	icaid facility described in paragraph
5	(3)(F), and the hospital's baseline
6	number of operating rooms, procedure
7	rooms, and beds for purposes of com-
8	pliance with this subparagraph shall
9	be automatically modified to reflect
10	such increase on a permanent basis.
11	"(II) Cornavirus 2020 Emer-
12	GENCY PERIOD DEFINED.—For pur-
13	poses of this clause, the 'coronavirus
14	2020 emergency period' is the period
15	beginning on March 13, 2020, and
16	ending on the last day on which the
17	emergency declared by the President
18	under section 501 of the Robert T.
19	Stafford Disaster Relief and Emer-
20	gency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C.
21	5191) with respect to SARS–CoV–2 $$
22	and coronavirus disease 2019 (abbre-
23	viated as COVID–19) is in effect.".
