## A BILL ENTITLED

## 1 AN ACT concerning

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## Natural Resources - Commercial Oyster Authorizations - Requirements

3 FOR the purpose of removing the authorization to harvest overers from the list of activities 4 authorized under an unlimited tidal fish license; altering the annual fees for certain 5 commercial oyster authorizations; requiring the Department of Natural Resources 6 to, by regulation, modify the total number of certain commercial oyster 7 authorizations based on certain factors; establishing certain limitations on the right 8 of a certain licensee to renew certain registrations and authorizations; for a certain 9 license year, requiring the Department to issue a certain commercial oyster authorization only to a licensee who meets certain requirements; requiring the 10 11 Department to allow a certain licensee to obtain a certain commercial oyster 12 authorization for a certain license year, notwithstanding a certain target; requiring 13 the Department to allow a licensee to renew a certain oyster authorization for a 14 certain license year only if the licensee paid the oyster surcharge to participate in 15 the immediately preceding oyster harvest season; providing for the relinquishment 16 and retirement of certain commercial oyster authorizations; requiring the 17 Department to reduce a certain target number to reflect the retirement of certain 18 commercial authorizations; making technical and conforming changes; and generally 19 relating to commercial oyster authorizations.

- 1 PERMANENTLY RETIRE EACH COMMERCIAL OYSTER 2 AUTHORIZATION RELINQUISHED UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH; AND
- 2. REDUCE THE TARGET NUMBER FOR COMMERCIAL
  OYSTER AUTHORIZATIONS UNDER SUBSECTION (J) OF THIS SECTION TO REFLECT
  THE RETIREMENT OF AUTHORIZATIONS UNDER THIS ITEM.
