3 SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON THE ADMISSION OF NON-4 IMMIGRANTS FROM NONCOMPLIANT COUN-5 TRIES.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Homeland Secu7 rity may not admit to the United States as a non8 immigrant under any category listed in subsection (b) any

national of a country that the Secretary has designated
 as noncompliant with respect to accepting the repatriation
 of nationals of that country who have been ordered re moved from the United States under the immigration laws
 (as such term is defined in section 101 of the Immigration
 and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101)).

7 (b) CATEGORIES OF NONIMMIGRANT VISAS.—The
8 categories listed in this subsection are subparagraphs (B),
9 (F), (H), (I), (J), (L), (M), (O), (P), and (Q) of section
10 101(a)(15) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8
11 U.S.C. 1101(a)(15)).
