A BILL

To provide that the Secretary of Homeland Security may not admit to the United States as a nonimmigrant under certain categories aliens who are nationals of noncompliant countries, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON THE ADMISSION OF NON-**
4 **IMMIGRANTS FROM NONCOMPLIANT COUN-**
5 **TRIES.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Homeland Secu-
7 rity may not admit to the United States as a non-
8 immigrant under any category listed in subsection (b) any

1 national of a country that the Secretary has designated
2 as noncompliant with respect to accepting the repatriation
3 of nationals of that country who have been ordered re-
4 moved from the United States under the immigration laws
5 (as such term is defined in section 101 of the Immigration
6 and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101)).

7 (b) CATEGORIES OF NONIMMIGRANT VISAS.—The
8 categories listed in this subsection are subparagraphs (B),
9 (F), (H), (I), (J), (L), (M), (O), (P), and (Q) of section
10 101(a)(15) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8
11 U.S.C. 1101(a)(15)).

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
