 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Stop Swaps, Protect
 - 5 Local Jobs Act".
 - 6 SEC. 2. PROJECT APPROVAL AND OVERSIGHT.
 - 7 Section 106(g) of title 23, United States Code, is
 - 8 amended by adding at the end the following:

"(6) FEDERAL FUNDING EXCHANGE PRO-GRAMS.—A State may implement a program under which a subrecipient has the option to exchange Federal funds allocated to such subrecipient in accordance with the requirements of this title for State or local funds if the State certifies to the Secretary that the State has prevailing wage and domestic content requirements that are comparable to the requirements under section 113 and 313 and that such requirements shall apply to projects carried out using such funds if such projects would have been subject to the requirements of sections 113 and 313 if such projects were carried out using Federal funds.".
