AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in fees, further providing for exemption of
3 persons, entities and vehicles from fees.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1901(c) and (d)(2) of Title 75 of the
7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended and subsection
8 (b) is amended by adding paragraphs to read:

9 § 1901. Exemption of persons, entities and vehicles from fees.

10 * * *

11 (b) Title and registration fees.--No fee shall be charged
12 for titling or registration of any of the following:

13 * * *

14 (6) Vehicles registered to a veteran who lost a limb or
15 eye or who became partially paralyzed while serving in the
16 armed forces of the United States.

17 (7) Vehicles registered to a person who, as a member of
18 the armed forces of the United States, was captured by the

1 enemy during World War II, the Korean Emergency, the Vietnam
2 Conflict or in a future armed conflict for which the
3 Department of Defense authorizes a campaign medal.

4 (8) Vehicles registered to a person who has been awarded
5 the Congressional Medal of Honor or the Purple Heart.

7 (c) Processing fee in lieu of registration fee.--No
8 registration fee shall be charged for vehicles registered by any
9 of the following but the department shall charge a fee of \$10 to
10 cover the costs of processing for issuing or renewing the
11 registration:

12 (1) Hospital.

13 (2) Humane society.

14 (3) Nonprofit youth center.

15 (4) American Red Cross.

16 (5) Church.

17 (6) Girl Scouts of America.

18 (7) Boy Scouts of America.

19 (8) Salvation Army.

20 (9) Duly chartered posts of national veterans'
21 organizations.

22 (10) Young Men's Christian Association.

23 (11) Young Men's Hebrew Association.

24 (12) Young Women's Christian Association.

25 (13) Young Women's Hebrew Association.

26 (14) Jewish Community Center.

27 (15) Nonprofit corporations of musical marching groups
28 of youths.

29 (16) Any person who is retired and receiving social
30 security or other pension and whose total annual income does

1 not exceed \$19,200. Unless the retired person is physically
2 or mentally incapable of driving the vehicle, the retired
3 person shall be the principal driver of the vehicle but may
4 from time to time authorize another person to drive the
5 vehicle in his or her stead.

6 [(17) Any veteran who lost a limb or eye or who became
7 partially paralyzed while serving in the armed forces of the
8 United States.]

9 (18) A person who, as a member of the armed forces of
10 the United States, was captured by the enemy during World War
11 I, World War II, the Korean Emergency, the Vietnam Conflict
12 or in a future armed conflict for which the Department of
13 Defense authorizes a campaign medal.

14 (19) Any person who has been awarded the Congressional
15 Medal of Honor.]

16 (20) Nonprofit organizations which care for or otherwise
17 provide services for the elderly or the infirm.

18 (21) Nonprofit organizations which principally serve
19 mentally or physically handicapped or disabled persons.

20 (22) Nonprofit mobile aviation museum.

21 (23) Nonprofit corporations that provide ambulance or
22 emergency medical services.

23 (d) Limitations.--

24 * * *

25 (2) Only one passenger car or truck with a registered
26 gross weight of not more than 9,000 pounds may be registered
27 to any person under the provisions of subsection (b) (4), (6),
28 (7) and (8) and subsection (c) (16) [, (17), (18) and (19)].

30 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
