## A BILL

To amend the Communications Act of 1934 to prohibit Federal funding for the Corporation for Public Broadcasting after fiscal year 2023.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON FEDERAL FUNDS FOR COR-**  
4 **PORATION FOR PUBLIC BROADCASTING**  
5 **AFTER FISCAL YEAR 2023.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 396 of the Communica-  
7 tions Act of 1934 (47 U.S.C. 396) is amended by adding  
8 at the end the following new subsection:

1       “(m) PROHIBITION ON FEDERAL FUNDS AFTER FIS-  
2 CAL YEAR 2023.—No Federal funds may be made avail-  
3 able to the Corporation for Public Broadcasting after fis-  
4 cal year 2023.”.

5       (b) CORPORATION PROHIBITED FROM ACCEPTING  
6 FEDERAL FUNDS.—Subsection (g) of such section is  
7 amended—

8           (1) in paragraph (2)(A), by inserting “subject  
9 to paragraph (3)(C),” before “obtain”; and

10          (2) in paragraph (3)—

11           (A) in subparagraph (A), by striking “;  
12 and” and inserting a semicolon;

13           (B) in subparagraph (B), by striking the  
14 period at the end and inserting “; and”; and

15           (C) by adding at the end the following new  
16 subparagraph:

17           “(C) accepting funds from the Federal Govern-  
18 ment after fiscal year 2023.”.

19       (c) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Subsection  
20 (k)(3)(A)(iv)(II) of such section is amended by inserting  
21 “through fiscal year 2023” after “amounts received”.
