## A BILL

- To provide for the coverage of non-congregate shelter under the Public Assistance program of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act for the emergency declared on March 13, 2020 relating to COVID-19, and for other purposes.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

### 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Coronavirus Emer-3 gency Non-Congregate Housing Expansion Act".

### 4 SEC. 2. NON-CONGREGATE SHELTER ASSISTANCE.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding sections 403, 406, 407, and 502 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Re-6 7 lief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5170b, 8 5172, 5173, 5192), for the emergency declared on March 9 13, 2020, by the President under section 501 of such Act 10 and under any subsequent major disaster declaration 11 under section 401 of such Act, the provision of non-con-12 gregate shelter shall be an eligible use of assistance pro-13 vided by the President under sections 403, 406, 407, or 14 502 of such Act.

(b) NON-FEDERAL SHARE.—Notwithstanding sections 403, 406, 407, and 503 of the Robert T. Stafford
Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C.
5170b, 5172, 5173, 5193), the Federal share of assistance
provided under sections 403, 406, 407, or 502 that is used
to provide non-congregate shelter in accordance with subsection (a) shall be 100 percent.

(c) NON-CONGREGATE SHELTER DEFINED.—In this
section, the term "non-congregate shelter" means shelter
for—

25 (1) individuals who test positive for COVID-19
26 that do not require hospitalization, but need isola•HR 6840 IH

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tion or quarantine (including individuals that are
 discharged from a hospital);

3 (2) individuals who have been exposed to
4 COVID-19 (as documented by a State or local pub5 lic health official or a medical professional) that do
6 not require hospitalization, but need isolation or
7 quarantine;

8 (3)individuals who are asymptomatic of 9 COVID-19, but have a higher risk, including indi-10 viduals over 65 or individuals with certain under-11 lying health conditions (including respiratory, com-12 promised immunities, and chronic disease), and that 13 require emergency non-congregate shelting as a so-14 cial distancing measure;

(4) first responders, healthcare workers, and
emergency workers that do not require hospitalization, but need isolation or quarantine (including individuals that are unable to return home as a precaution against exposing the families or housemates
of such individual to COVID-19); and

(5) homeless individuals that have not been exposed or have not tested positive for COVID-19, but
require emergency non-congregate sheltering to adhere to social distancing measures.
