- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Pottawattamie County
- 5 Reversionary Interest Conveyance Act".

1	SEC. 2. CONVEYANCE OF REVERSIONARY INTEREST RE-
2	QUIRED.
3	(a) Conveyance.—Not later than 90 days after the
4	date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior
5	shall convey, without consideration, to the State of Iowa
6	the reversionary interest held by the United States and
7	described in the quitclaim deed dated April 13, 1998, in-
8	strument number 19170, as recorded in book 98, page
9	55015, in Pottawattamie County, Iowa.
10	(b) Costs.—As a condition of the conveyance under
11	subsection (a), all costs associated with the conveyance
12	under that subsection shall be paid by the State of Iowa,
13	including the costs of the phase I environmental site as-
14	sessment.
15	SEC. 3. SENSE OF CONGRESS RELATING TO PROVISION OF
16	INFORMATION RELATING TO CERTAIN NA-
17	TIONAL HISTORIC TRAILS.
18	It is the sense of Congress that the State of Iowa
19	should continue to provide information relating to the
20	Lewis and Clark National Historic Trail, the California
21	National Historic Trail, and the Mormon Pioneer National
