A BILL

To prohibit the enforcement of a nondisclosure agreement based on an individual's employment in the Executive Office of the President if the disclosure of information in violation of the agreement is based on whistleblowing.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Disrupting Ac-
5 countability Act” or the “NDA Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF ENFORCEMENT OF NONDISCLO-**
2 **SURE AGREEMENTS WITH EXECUTIVE OF-**
3 **FICE OF THE PRESIDENT IF DISCLOSURE IS**
4 **BASED ON WHISTLEBLOWING.**

5 (a) PROHIBITION.—A nondisclosure agreement based
6 on an individual’s employment in the Executive Office of
7 the President or the White House may not be enforced
8 against the individual if the individual’s disclosure of in-
9 formation in violation of the agreement is described under
10 section 2302(b)(8) of title 5, United States Code.

11 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section shall apply with
12 respect to a nondisclosure agreement entered into before,
13 on, or after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
