A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to extend eligibility for a certain work-study allowance paid by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to certain individuals who pursue programs of rehabilitation, education, or training on at least a half-time basis, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "Student Veteran Work
- 3 Study Modernization Act".
- 4 SEC. 2. PILOT PROGRAM TO EXPAND ELIGIBILITY FOR A
- 5 CERTAIN WORK-STUDY ALLOWANCE PAID BY
- 6 THE SECRETARY OF VETERANS AFFAIRS TO
- 7 CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS WHO PURSUE CER-
- 8 TAIN PROGRAMS ON AT LEAST A HALF-TIME
- 9 BASIS.
- 10 (a) PILOT PROGRAM.—The Secretary of Veterans Af-
- 11 fairs shall carry out a pilot program under which the Sec-
- 12 retary shall expand eligibility for the work-study allowance
- 13 under section 3485 of title 38, United States Code, to in-
- 14 dividuals who are pursuing programs of rehabilitation,
- 15 education, or training specified in subsection (b) of such
- 16 section at a rate equal to at least half of that required
- 17 of a full-time student.
- 18 (b) Relationship to Other Work-Study Indi-
- 19 VIDUALS.—In carrying out the pilot program under sub-
- 20 section (a), the Secretary shall ensure the provisions of
- 21 section 3485 of title 38, United States Code, apply with
- 22 respect to the individuals specified in subsection (a) of this
- 23 section in the same manner as to the individuals specified
- 24 in subsection (b) of such section 3485, except with respect
- 25 to the requirement of at least three-quarter-time student
- 26 status.

- 1 (c) Duration.—The Secretary shall carry out the
- 2 pilot program under subsection (a) during the five-year
- 3 period beginning on the date of the commencement of the
- 4 pilot program.

5 SEC. 3. ANNUAL REPORT REGARDING VETERANS WHO PAR-

- 6 TICIPATE IN WORK-STUDY.
- 7 Not later than 180 days after the date of the enact-
- 8 ment of this Act and annually thereafter, the Secretary
- 9 of Veterans Affairs shall submit to the Committees on
- 10 Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and House of Representa-
- 11 tives a report regarding veterans who participate in work-
- 12 study. Such report shall include the following elements:
- 13 (1) The number of such veterans.
- 14 (2) The percentage of such veterans who obtain
- a four-year degree.
- 16 (3) The number of such veterans who obtain
- full-time work at the Department of Veterans Af-
- fairs.

19 SEC. 4. DETERMINATION OF BUDGETARY EFFECTS.

- The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of
- 21 complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010,
- 22 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement
- 23 titled "Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation" for this
- 24 Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record
- 25 by the Chairman of the House Budget Committee, pro-

- 2 vote on passage.

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
