## A BILL

To amend the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 to expand the military student identifier program to cover students with a parent who serves in the reserve component of the Armed Forces.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Supporting Children  
5 of the National Guard and Reserve Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ANNUAL STATE REPORT CARD.**

2       Section 1111(h)(1)(C)(ii) of the Elementary and Sec-  
3 ondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C.  
4 6311(h)(1)(C)(ii)) is amended by striking “on active duty  
5 (as defined in section 101(d)(5) of such title)”.
