- [(b)] (C) (1) (i) The Department shall adopt regulations governing procedures for requesting, obtaining, and examining financial records that the Department determines are necessary to verify or confirm an individual's eligibility or ineligibility for public assistance.
- 7 (ii) The regulations shall include reimbursement schedules 8 necessary to compensate fiduciary institutions for complying with this section.
- 9 (2) The Secretary shall notify a fiduciary institution of the officers or 10 employees of the Department who are authorized to request and receive financial records 11 from the fiduciary institution.
- 12 (3) An individual authorized to receive information under this section may 13 not disclose any personally identifiable information obtained or maintained under this 14 section.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2017.
