BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Real Property Section 11-109.2 and 11B-112.2 Annotated Code of Maryland (2015 Replacement Volume and 2019 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Real Property 11-109.2.


