1	SEC. 2. WATER CONSERVATION OR IRRIGATION EFFI-
2	CIENCY PRACTICE WAIVER AUTHORITY.
3	Section $1240B(h)(2)$ of the Food Security Act of
4	1985 (16 U.S.C. 3839aa– $2(h)(2)$) is amended by striking
5	subparagraphs (C) and (D) and inserting the following:
6	"(C) WAIVER AUTHORITY.—The Secretary
7	shall waive the applicability of the limitations in
8	sections 1001D(b) and 1240G for a payment
9	made under a contract entered into under this
10	paragraph if the payment does not exceed—
11	"(i) the product obtained by multi-
12	plying—
13	"(I) the maximum payment
14	under section 1240G; and
15	"(II) the number of producers
16	served by the contract through the en-
17	tity that is party to the contract; less
18	"(ii) the sum of any other payments
19	received under the program during the pe-
20	riod of fiscal years 2024 through 2028
21	by—
22	"(I) producers served by the con-
23	tract; and
24	"(II) the entity that is party to
25	the contract, limited to the proportion

1of those payments that benefit the2producers served by the contract.".
