A RESOLUTION

- 1 Creating the Joint Study Committee on Incorporating Law Enforcement in the Pathway to

- 4 WHEREAS, communities across the country are launching pre-arrest diversion initiatives
- 5 designed to better address law enforcement's encounters with people who have challenges
- 6 with drug use and mental health; and
- 7 WHEREAS, policing and the community can be helped when law enforcement can
- 8 successfully serve as a sizeable pathway to treatment and social services in behavioral health
- 9 interventions; and
- 10 WHEREAS, study is needed on strategically widening community behavioral health and
- social service options available through law enforcement diversion, including, but not limited
- 12 to, matters of funding, data collection, outcomes, and long-term impact.
- 13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 GEORGIA:
- 15 (1) **Creation of joint study committee.** There is created the Joint Study Committee on
- 16 Incorporating Law Enforcement in the Pathway to Treatment and Social Services for
- 17 Persons Having Challenges with Drug Use and Mental Health.
- 18 (2) **Members and officers.** The committee shall be composed of six members appointed
- 19 as follows:
- 20 (A) Three members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the
- House of Representatives, who shall designate one of their number to serve as
- cochairperson; and
- 23 (B) Three members of the Senate appointed by the President of the Senate, who shall
- designate one of their number to serve as cochairperson.

25 (3) **Powers and duties.** The committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs,

- 26 issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action or
- legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate.
- 28 (4) **Meetings.** The cochairpersons shall call all meetings of the committee. The
- committee may conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem
- 30 necessary or convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform
- its duties, and accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution.

32 (5) Allowances, expenses, and funding.

- 33 (A) The legislative members of the committee shall receive the allowances provided
- for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated.
- 35 (B) The allowances and expenses authorized by this resolution shall not be received
- 36 by any member of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are
- authorized. Funds necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come
- from funds appropriated to the House of Representatives and the Senate.

39 (6) **Report.**

- 40 (A) In the event the committee adopts any specific findings or recommendations that
- 41 include suggestions for proposed legislation, the cochairpersons shall file a report of the
- same prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution, subject to
- subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.
- (B) In the event the committee adopts a report that does not include suggestions for
- proposed legislation, the cochairpersons shall file the report, subject to
- subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.
- 47 (C) No report shall be filed unless the same has been approved prior to the date of
- abolishment specified in this resolution by majority vote of a quorum of the committee.
- A report so approved shall be signed by the cochairpersons of the committee and filed
- with the Clerk of the House of Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate.
- 51 (D) In the absence of an approved report, the cochairpersons may file with the Clerk
- of the House of Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate copies of the minutes
- of the meetings of the committee in lieu thereof.
- 54 (7) **Abolishment.** The committee shall stand abolished on December 31, 2018.
