3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "No Bailouts for Illegal5 Aliens Act".

1SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON THE USE OF FUNDS TO OFFSET2STIMULUS CHECKS TO ILLEGAL ALIENS.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Title XIII of the Emergency Ap4 propriations for Coronavirus Health Response and Agency
5 Operations (division B of Public Law 116–136) is amend6 ed—

7 (1) by redesignating section 23008 as section8 23009; and

9 (2) by inserting after section 23007 the fol-10 lowing:

11 "SEC. 23008. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act or any amendment made by this Act, no funds 12 13 made available under this Act or by any amendment made by this Act, may be made available to a State or munici-14 pality (as such terms are defined in section 4002 of divi-15 16 sion A) unless the State or municipality has certified that it is not providing relief funds or similar monetary pay-17 ments of any kind that are targeted exclusively to individ-18 19 uals who are believed to be unlawfully present in the 20 United States.".

(b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendment made by subsection (a)(2) shall apply to any funds made available
under the CARES Act (Public Law 116–136) on or after
the date of the enactment of that Act.
