- 14 WHEREAS, more than 100 students from her chapter have received their Georgia FFA
- degrees, and approximately 15 have gone on to earn the American FFA degree; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the chapter has produced ten state proficiency winners under Ms. Clark's
- 17 leadership, with two of these proficiency finalists continuing on to become national finalists
- and one winning in their respective areas; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Ms. Clark has been the recipient of numerous awards and accolades over the
- 20 course of her career, including being named Teacher of the Year for Sonoraville High School
- 21 and Gordon Central High School, Agricultural Education Teacher of the Year for Georgia,
