- 24 (1) FOR A FIRST VIOLATION, A FINE OF \$1,000;
- 25 (2) FOR A SECOND VIOLATION, A FINE OF \$3,000 AND A SUSPENSION 26 OF THE LOCAL DELIVERY SERVICE PERMIT FOR 30 DAYS;
- 27 (3) FOR A THIRD VIOLATION, A FINE OF \$6,000 AND A SUSPENSION OF 28 THE LOCAL DELIVERY SERVICE PERMIT FOR 60 DAYS; AND
