Mrs. KIGGANS of Virginia introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Appropriations

A BILL

To make continuing appropriations for military pay in the event of a Government shutdown.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Pay Our Troops Act".

5 SEC. 2. CONTINUING APPROPRIATIONS FOR MEMBERS OF 6 THE ARMED FORCES.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—There are hereby appropriated for
8 fiscal year 2024, out of any money in the Treasury not
9 otherwise appropriated, for any period during which in10 terim or full-year appropriations for fiscal year 2024 are

1 not in effect, such sums as are necessary to provide pay2 and allowances to—

3 (1) members of the Armed Forces, including
4 the reserve components thereof, who perform active
5 service during such period;

6 (2) civilian employees of the Department of De-7 fense (and the Department of Homeland Security in 8 the case of the Coast Guard when the Coast Guard 9 is not operating as a service in the Department of 10 the Navy) whom the Secretary concerned determines 11 are providing support to members of the Armed 12 Forces described in paragraph (1); and

(3) contractors of the Department of Defense
(and the Department of Homeland Security in the
case of the Coast Guard when the Coast Guard is
not operating as a service in the Department of the
Navy) whom the Secretary concerned determines are
providing support to members of the Armed Forces
described in paragraph (1).

(b) TERMINATION.—Appropriations and funds made
available and authority granted pursuant to this Act shall
be available until whichever of the following occurs first:
(1) The enactment into law of an appropriation
(including a continuing appropriation) for any pur-

1	pose for which amounts are made available by sub-
2	section (a).
3	(2) The enactment into law of the applicable
4	regular or continuing appropriations resolution or
5	other Act without any appropriation for such pur-
6	pose.
7	(3) January 1, 2025.
8	(c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
9	(1) The terms "active service" and "Armed
10	Forces" have the meanings given such terms in sec-
11	tion 101 of title 10, United States Code.
12	(2) The term "reserve components" means the
13	components named in section 10101 of title 10,
14	United States Code.
15	(3) The term "Secretary concerned" means—
16	(A) the Secretary of Defense with respect
17	to matters concerning the Department of De-
18	fense; and
19	(B) the Secretary of Homeland Security
20	with respect to matters concerning the Coast
21	Guard when the Coast Guard is not operating
22	as a service in the Department of the Navy.
