1	SECTION 1. REVISION OF QUORUM REQUIREMENT FOR
2	THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE EXPORT-
3	IMPORT BANK OF THE UNITED STATES.
4	(a) In General.—Section 3(c)(6) of the Export-Im-
5	port Bank Act of 1945 (12 U.S.C. 635a(c)(6)) is amended
6	by striking "at least three members" and inserting "the
7	lesser of 3 members or the number of members holding
8	office on the Board".
9	(b) Conforming Repeal.—Public Law 106–46 (12
10	U.S.C. 635a note) is repealed.
