A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Task Force to Study the Feasibility of a Bowie State University Law School

3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Task Force to Study the Feasibility of a Bowie State University Law School; providing for the composition, chair, and staffing of the Task 4 $\mathbf{5}$ Force; prohibiting a member of the Task Force from receiving certain compensation, 6 but authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring the Task Force to 7 study and make recommendations regarding the feasibility of establishing a Bowie 8 State University Law School; requiring the Task Force to report its findings and 9 recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Task 1011 Force to Study the Feasibility of a Bowie State University Law School.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,13 That:
