BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Georgia Recognizing Veterans Act."

8 SECTION 2.

Code Section 40-5-36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to veterans' licenses, honorary licenses, and other distinctive licenses, is amended by revising subsection (c) as follows:

- "(c) Veterans' licenses may be issued to:
 - (1) Veterans veterans who were are residents of Georgia at the time of enlistment or commissioning and are residents at the time of application for the license, or who have been residents of Georgia for at least two years immediately preceding the date of application for the license, and who served on active duty in the armed forces of the United States or on active duty in a reserve component of the armed forces of the United States, including the National Guard of this state or any other state, during wartime or any conflict when personnel were committed by the President of the United States, whether or not such veteran was assigned to a unit or division which directly participated in such war or conflict, except for periodic transfer from reserve status to active duty status for training purposes, and who were discharged or separated under honorable conditions; and (2) All members or former members of the National Guard or reserve forces who have 20 or more years' creditable service therein. Any veteran making application for a license under this subsection shall submit or cause to be submitted to the department verification

26	that he or she was discharged or separated from such service under honorable conditions
27	by such means as required by rules and regulations of the department."
