13	access to impacted areas, thereby completing critical assessments and begin raising more
14	than ten million dollars in nongovernmental revenue and recruiting more than six thousand
15	volunteers; and
16	WHEREAS, through the efforts of SMHA, volunteers worked on the recovery of one
17	thousand sixty-four homes, businesses, and churches across coastal Louisiana; and
18	WHEREAS, Southern Mutual Help Association has proven to be an essential
