3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Resist Executive Am-
- 5 nesty on Defense Installations Act" or the "READI Act".

1	SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON USE OF MILITARY INSTALLA-
2	TIONS TO HOUSE ALIENS WHO DO NOT HAVE
3	A LAWFUL IMMIGRATION STATUS OR ARE UN-
4	DERGOING REMOVAL PROCEEDINGS IN THE
5	UNITED STATES.
6	(a) Prohibition.—A military installation may not
7	be used to house any alien unlawfully present in the
8	United States.
9	(b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
10	(1) The term "alien unlawfully present" means
11	an alien who—
12	(A) is covered by the rule of construction
13	regarding unlawful presence contained in sec-
14	tion $212(a)(9)(B)(ii)$ of the Immigration and
15	Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. $1182(a)(9)(B)(ii))$; or
16	(B) is undergoing removal proceedings in
17	the United States.
18	(2) The term "military installation" has the
19	meaning given that term in section $2801(c)(4)$ of
20	title 10, United States Code, but does not include an
21	installation located outside of the United States.
