A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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### Baltimore City Community College – Procurement Authority

3 FOR the purpose of exempting Baltimore City Community College from certain provisions 4 of State procurement law; requiring the Board of Trustees of the College, subject to  $\mathbf{5}$ review and approval by the Board of Public Works and the Joint Committee on 6 Administrative, Executive, and Legislative Review, to develop certain policies and 7 procedures governing procurement; requiring the Board of Trustees to develop an 8 information technology plan that meets certain requirements; exempting the College 9 from certain provisions of law relating to the purchase, lease, or rental of information 10 technology or any changes to the purchase, lease, or rental of information technology; 11 exempting the College from certain provisions of law governing telecommunication 12systems or services; exempting the College from certain provisions of law governing 13 the oversight of public improvement projects by the Department of General Services; 14 requiring the Department, on request of the Board of Public Works, to advise the 15Board of Public Works on certain contracts for the College that exceed a certain 16amount under certain circumstances; requiring the Board of Public Works to review 17and approve certain contracts that exceed a certain amount under certain 18 circumstances; requiring certain procurements by the College to comply with certain 19policies and procedures; establishing the authority of the State Board of Contract 20Appeals over certain contract claims by the College before and after a certain date; 21exempting the College from a certain review of a certain contract for certain 22expenditures; subjecting a certain contract for certain expenditures to certain 23approval; altering a certain definition; making stylistic changes; and generally 24relating to the procurement authority of Baltimore City Community College.
